## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Since 2015, the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) and the volunteer-led Universal Acceptance Steering Group (UASG) have been working together to promote the Universal Acceptance (UA) of all valid domain names and email addresses. These include domain names and email addresses in different languages and scripts (also known as Internationalized Domain Names or IDNs), and of varying length (long top-level domains).

ICANN and UASG are actively engaging with key stakeholders including technology enablers, developers, email software providers, administrators, domain registries, academia and government policymakers to:

- Raise awareness of UA:
- Provide UA training and remediation through bug reports and implementation of fixes, and:
- Promote UA adoption by developing relevant resources, such as guidelines, gap analyses, case studies and training materials.

Universal Acceptance Activities Report highlights:

- Outreach and engagement activities by ICANN and UASG, particularly by UA Local Initiatives and UA Ambassadors.
- Technical training materials on programming languages and email configuration.
- Publications to promote UA adoption.
- A summary of UA Day 2023 events.
- The role of the community in contributing to an inclusive and multilingual Internet.

## UNIVERSAL ACCEPTANCE FOR DIGITAL INCLUSION

Universal Acceptance (UA) is the state in which all valid domain names and email addresses, including IDNs and those formed with the new gTLDs, are accepted and treated consistently by all Internet-enabled software and applications. Achieving UA ensures that Internet users can effectively navigate and communicate online using a chosen domain name and email address that best aligns with their interests, business, culture, language and script. Therefore, UA is a foundational requirement for achieving meaningful online access by enabling consumer choice and digital inclusion.

Achieving UA is only possible through the joint efforts and cooperation of various stakeholders. The UASG and ICANN have made significant progress in promoting global awareness of UA and contributed to a remarkable inaugural UA Day in 2023. In addition to UA Day, of which a report has been published in six UN languages, UASG and ICANN organized various activities and events held across the globe through experts, UA ambassadors, Local Initiatives, and volunteers.



# 1. UNIVERSAL ACCEPTANCE STEERING GROUP (UASG)

In 2015, the ICANN community formed the Universal Acceptance Steering Group (UASG), a volunteer-led organization supported by ICANN org that aims to promote UA awareness and create relevant technical know-how for addressing UA remediation to eventually promote UA adoption.

The vision of the UASG is:

All domain names and all email addresses work in all software applications

The mission of the UASG is:

To mobilize the software application developers to get their products UA-ready by providing encouragement, documentation, case studies, tools and measures to deliver the right user experience to the end user

#### 1.1 OVERVIEW

UASG publishes the following annual reports:

- 1. UASG Action Plan
- 2. UA-Readiness Report

The FY23 UA-Readiness Report mainly covers current gaps in technology related to UA-readiness, and provides an update on the remediation activities undertaken by the UASG in FY23 (July 2022 – June 2023). It also aims to identify necessary materials to achieve UA-readiness.

In addition, the UA Activities Report aims to summarize the outreach and training activities of the UASG, ICANN, and contributing stakeholders between July 2022 and November 2023. It also aims to give the audience ideas on how they can contribute and roles for each stakeholder. This report provides a comprehensive overview of the collaborative efforts and achievements, in alignment with the objectives outlined in the past year's Action Plan.

The focus of this report is to highlight key initiatives, outreach activities, technical training, publications, and the successful UA Day event that have collectively advanced the cause of UA.

The information provided in the report demonstrates the effort taken to spread UA across the globe through training materials to address and fix UA-related issues. This report is a valuable resource for the entire UA community and anyone looking for UA training resources and information on getting involved in promoting UA.



# 2. OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITIES FOR UA **ADOPTION**

Outreach and engagement activities to promote UA are done through multiple channels, including:

- UASG Local Initiatives
- UASG Ambassador Program
- ICANN Universal Acceptance Program and Global Stakeholder Engagement
- UASG and ICANN websites and social media channels.
- UA Day

The outreach and engagement activities conducted between Jul 2022 and November 2023 are summarized in this section.

#### 2.1 UA LOCAL INITIATIVES

UA Local Initiatives are among the UASG's core projects and are led by community groups and stakeholders around the world. Members of UA Local Initiatives collaborate with UASG leadership, UA Working Groups, and ICANN to address UA-readiness in their regions by engaging with local stakeholders. There are now a total of five UA Local Initiatives based in China, Commonwealth of Independent States-Eastern Europe (CIS-EE), India, Sri Lanka and Thailand. This section explains the core activities of the Local Initiatives.

# 2.1.1 CHINA UA LOCAL INITIATIVE

The Chinese Domain Names Initiative (CDNI) of the Internet Society of China (ISC) was established on 9 January 2020. With the leadership of CDNI and the support of ICANN, the UASG, and three UA Ambassadors, a series of outreach, training and industry engagement sessions with stakeholders was carried out to actively promote UA-readiness.

CDNI continued to move the UA-readiness process forward in China through efforts of outreach, training, industry event engagement, and awareness education.

The support of Chinese domain names by Internet applications is varied. According to the Test Report of Chinese Internationalized Domain Names conducted by CDNI, the overall support rate for the Universal Acceptance of Chinese domain names reaches 35%. More information can be found on the blog published about this testing report.

The current challenge is how to further facilitate and motivate more Internet service providers to adopt UA-readiness through market engagement and cultivation.

The following are some of the major activities conducted by the Local Initiative in China:



1. Global Digital Summit addresses domain names and its business related to cloud computing, digital marketing, AI, and cross-border e-commerce. About 1,000 people participated representing different sectors including government, email services providers, tech developers and enablers, DNS industry, academia, and more. More information is available on the event website.



15 June 2023. Co-organized the 5th session of the Global Digital Summit to promote Chinese domain name awareness.

2. Top annual industry event to address the development of Chinese domain name application and development through keynote sharing, policy discussions, and showcasing of the "Chinese Domain Name Universal Acceptance Test System" for UA-readiness of applications. This event also started the discussion of future UA Day events with KNET Co. Ltd., followed by a correspondence between KNET and the ICANN Board. Over 200 people participated representing the government, email providers, tech developers and enablers, DNS industry, and academia. More information is available on the event website.



20 April 2023. Co-organized the 6th session of Chinese IDN Innovation Application Forum and released the Test Report of Chinese Internationalized Domain Names.

3. The local event to echo the global UA Day 2023 focused on how to promote UA-readiness of Chinese domain names by different Internet applications, and how to enhance EAI-readiness adoption was held in Beijing, China. EAI training was conducted during the event. Over 100 people participated on-site and over 1,900 participated online. More information is available on the event website.





28 March 2023. UA Day awareness and EAI training.

4. Over 200 representatives from the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT), China Internet Network Information Center (CNNIC), CONAC, members of ISC, public organizations, registries and registrars, email service providers, web administrators, and engineers participated in the Forum. More information is available on the <u>event website</u>.



30 August 2022. Co-organized the 5th session of Chinese IDN Innovation Application Forum to introduce best practices and good samples of Chinese domain name applications.

5. Series of online UA training events were organized on the general introduction of UA, the significance of Chinese IDNs, international progress and domestic policy support, EAI development, and efforts made by the Chinese Internet community. About 50 people followed the training program.



14 July 2022. Co-organized a series of UA training courses online during the COVID-19 pandemic.



#### 2.1.2 CIS-EE UA LOCAL INITIATIVE

The Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) and Eastern Europe (EE) UA Local Initiative was set up by the regional community in 2019. During FY23, it gathered experts from nine countries: Armenia, Belarus, Georgia, Latvia, Russia, Serbia and Ukraine, with new members from Azerbaijan and Kyrgyzstan. The members are mostly representatives of IDN ccTLD and new gTLD registries, registrars and local IT companies from the region. There is also a chapter of the CIS-EE UA Local Initiative - the Russian Working Group on Universal Acceptance - that has continued its work on UA adoption in Russia since 2020 (https://универсальноепринятие.pd/).

The members of the CIS-EE UA Local Initiative work closely with local communities and key stakeholders within their respective countries. The level of UA awareness and adoption varies from country to country. There is still the need to grow awareness of UA and IDN benefits and technology gaps preventing their total support in Internet-enabled software, as well as UA remediation global efforts. For that, the CIS-EE UA Local Initiative members continue to carry out local outreach and engagement activities on UA, IDNs, and EAI implementation. The following are a few of them:



1. 17 October 2022. Webinar on UA as a part of socio-cultural section IG for participants of the Russian Summer School on Internet Governance, with 95 participants (lecturers, students, young specialists) from 7 countries. Held by the Coordination Center for TLD .RU/.PΦ. (Russia)



2. 20 November 2022. Session "Multilingualism on the Internet and .ge zone" at the GeoIGF 2022 forum that gathered up to 45 speakers and 90 registered participants from public, private, civil society and academic institutions. The CIS-EE UA LI members from Armenia and Georgia took part in the session. Discussion was held on the state of Georgian language on the Internet, with updates on UA and IDN activities. (Georgia)








3. 13 December 2022. Special Award "Traveling through .PΦ" was established within the biggest annual ceremony "Premia Runeta," celebrating keynote Internet achievements and projects in Russia, for wider awareness of IDNs and UA among the local Internet community. Over 300 people from government/business/tech developers/DNS industry/academia sectors participated in the ceremony. Organized by the Coordination Center for TLD .RU/.PФ. (Russia)





4. 27 January 2023. Public event to present a new Serbian Cyrillic font and facilitate debate on the topic of the Serbian language and artificial intelligence. The new fonts and IDN event were promoted on social media and the story of Cyrillic script use was discussed in the media, analyzing the current conditions but also options to preserve global lingual and cultural diversity online. Organized by the RNIDS. (Serbia)



5. 8 February 2023. Award ceremony of the website contest on .huj domain to educate on Armenian script and IDN usage and advantages, promote UA adoption and announce UA Day event. More than 50 website administrators,



government officials, academics, DNS industry experts, media, etc. participated. Organized by the Internet Society NGO. (Armenia)



6. 10 May 2023. Press conference to publicly celebrate Armenian IDN ccTLD anniversary and discuss its future, including plans for UA adoption and launching EAI mail platform in Armenian script. Organized by the Internet Society, NGO. (Armenia)

In FY23, a series of UA awareness and training events for the local youth generation and academia sector were started in Russia. This initiative will be continued in FY24. The Coordination Center for TLD .RU/.PΦ organized several events in collaboration with local universities and youth projects, as follows:





7. 12 May 2023. Seminar on "How to match user language preferences on the Internet" at the III Youth RIGF. The workshop observed the current status of the Russian language on the Internet and how UA adoption helps to match user preferences on usage of local language. Over 1,400 people (onsite and online) from government/ public organizations/ tech developers/ academia and students of several Russian universities participated in the forum.





8. 17 May 2023, presentation on socio-cultural and technical aspects of the local language development on the Internet, including IDN and UA adoption, at the XI Youth forum "Ethical, Cultural and Civilization aspects of work on the Internet." Over 200 participants: students of MTUCI and representatives of government, academia, tech developers and DNS industry sectors.



9. 19 May 2023. Seminar "Internationalization of domain and email addressing: theory and practice." Awareness lecture and practical examples of UA adoption to train about 30 students of digital faculty at MAI.

To foster UA adoption and train local tech developers and enablers, email and hosting providers, there were a number of technical trainings conducted in Russia during FY23:



10.17 August 2022. Online training for system administrators "How set up email service based on IDN .PΦ." The event explained UA as a concept, IDN and EAI requirements and demonstrated practical steps on how to set up EAI mail service using open-source mail products. It gathered over 20 online participants. The recording is available here.



11. 22-23 September 2022. Workshop on EAI was organized at the biggest professional conference for high load systems developers, Saint Highload ++



2022, where over 1,000 people from tech developers and enablers, email services providers, business, academia participated.

- 12.6 December 2022. Workshop to discuss IDN and UA adoption best practices, remediation updates and what role hosting providers play in these processes, was carried out at Hostobzor 2022 with about 70 participants from the DNS industry and hosting providers (closed industry meeting).
- 13.28 March 2023. To contribute to UA Day 2023, the CIS-EE UA Local Initiative members conducted a regional conference devoted to strategic and practical aspects of UA-readiness achievement. The event included training on supporting EAI in email servers given by Abdalmonem Galila, UASG Vice Chair at that time. The event was hosted by the Internet Society NGO (Armenia). Over 100 people participated on-site from government, tech developers and enablers, email providers, DNS industry and academia sectors. More information: https://uaday.am/.





For UA global outreach, the CIS-EE UA Local Initiative members also participated in a variety of regional and global events during FY23, such as IGF 2022, Africa IGF 2022, ICANN75, APTLD82, TLDCON 2022 and others.

As for UA remediation efforts, the continued dialogue with local software developers are in progress. As a result of FY23 efforts, more local software manufacturers started to work on UA-readiness in Russia, e.g., ispmanager (web hosting panel) launched a new release with EAI Level-1 support in September 2023. Since 2023 two EAI testbeds have become available for local developer communities in Armenia and Russia (in Armenian and Cyrillic scripts accordingly).

The Guidelines on linkification for URLs with non-ASCII characters and Recommendations for development of a registration and authentication module using internationalized email addresses were developed by the CIS-EE UA Local Initiative members and shared with the UASG community.

Several explainer materials with guick guides for end users on how they can improve their current user experience when using IDN or EAI were also published, including: how to copy-paste Cyrillic URLs with Unicode symbols, how to type sign @ in EAI addresses without switching a keyboard to English language, manuals on how to set up EAI mail services and other publications - available on the local UA-related portal поддерживаю.pф (in Russian).



#### 2.1.3 INDIA UA LOCAL INITIATIVE

The FICCI-Indian Language Internet Alliance is a multistakeholder alliance established with the aim of sustainable development of the Indic Internet and Language Technology Sector of India. Carrying forward the same momentum, and with the support of ICANN, FICCI-ILIA started hosting the India UA Local Initiative in 2019. The prime objective of this initiative is to promote the concept of Universal Acceptance within India, thereby facilitating greater online participation and enabling individuals to harness the power of the Internet in their local languages.

Over the years, FICCI-ILIA has undertaken various initiatives aimed at fostering the development and sustainable growth of Universal Acceptance in India with a particular focus on UA implementation, EAI, and IDNs. Outlined below are some key highlights of the UA Local Initiative in India:

- 1. 4 November 2022. Training Workshop and Hackathon Session on Programming for Supporting UA, in Pune: The event proved to be a noteworthy event. It drew the active participation of 30 technical community members. This event exemplified a commitment to continuous learning, innovation and knowledge sharing in the Indian technology sector, enriching the industry with insights from globally renowned trainers.
- 2. 28 March 2023. Technical Training Workshop on UA and EAI Implementation and Adoption: The session emphasized the importance of UA and EAI in digital inclusion, particularly within educational institutions. The session facilitated in-depth discussions and interactive Q&A, providing participants with insights into the benefits of UA and EAI adoption. Attendees gained a clearer understanding of the challenges and opportunities, equipping them to drive positive change in their organizations and contribute to an inclusive digital ecosystem.
- 3. 25 April 2023. Technical Training Workshop on Bridging the Language Gap
  - with UA and its Capacity Building: The technical training workshop emphasized the importance of UA for inclusivity and accessibility, particularly in regional languages, as well as the efforts of the UASG and ICANN in promoting global UA standards. It also highlighted insights on capacity building for UA implementation and the need for continuous education and skill



development. The event drew an audience of 200-plus participants.



- 4. 9 May 2023. Future Skilling Sessions (Startup Community) Session on Universal Acceptance: A Key to Unlocking Growth Opportunities for Startups and MSMEs: The session highlighted the transformative potential of UA and multilingual Internet in fostering growth opportunities for startups and MSMEs. It provided valuable insights to 100-plus participants from the startup and MSME communities.
- 5. 2 June 2023. Government Engagement Meeting with Shri Nikuni Kumar Srivastava, IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of IT, Government of Madhya Pradesh: The session focused on the significance of UA and EAI for social transformation. The discussion explored how UA can positively impact people's lives and promote inclusive access to government services in local languages. The meeting highlighted the importance of government departments adopting UA standards to enable citizens to access information and services in their preferred languages. The LI secretariat emphasized the potential of UA and EAI in driving social transformation, empowering individuals, and creating a more inclusive and accessible digital environment in Madhya Pradesh.



- 6. 14 June 2023. Future Skilling Sessions (Startup Community), Session on Users Acquisition with Multilingual Internet and Universal Acceptance and its Role in Business Growth: The Local India UA chapter organized an informative session on "User Acquisition with Multilingual Internet and Universal Acceptance for Business Growth." The interactive session highlighted the importance of a multilingual Internet in the global business landscape, emphasizing how catering to diverse linguistic preferences can enhance user acquisition and business growth. It also covered practical strategies, along with case studies illustrating the positive impact of multilingual Internet and UA on business growth and customer satisfaction.
- 7. 16 June 2023. Government Engagement, Meeting with Shri Manoj Kumar Pattnaik, Additional Secretary, Department of Science and IT, Government of Odisha: A government engagement meeting was held on UA and its implementation benefits, emphasizing the importance of government departments adopting UA standards. The meeting highlighted the potential of



UA in driving social transformation and empowering individuals and communities, creating a more inclusive digital environment in Odisha.

- 8. 19 June 2023, Awareness and Promotion Sessions Awareness Session on Building an Indic-Internet for All: Universal Acceptance and the Future of Digital Inclusion: The local India Chapter organized an awareness session titled "Building an Indic-Internet for All: Universal Acceptance and the Future of Digital Inclusion" in Bhopal. The event was attended by 120 people from academia and the UA community. The interactive session provided insights on the practical aspects of UA, addressing challenges faced by non-Latin script users and proposing solutions for bridging the digital divide. It covered ICANN's efforts in promoting UA and its impact on digital inclusion in South Asia, along with experiences and research on Indic-language Internet usage, emphasizing the need for technological advancements for a truly inclusive digital environment.
- 9. 19 June 2023. Future Skilling Sessions (Academia & Research) Session on Universal Acceptance and Multilingual Internet - Career Growth and Development:

The local India UA chapter organized a capacity-building session titled "Universal Acceptance and Multilingual Internet - Career Growth and Development." It provided specialized training on the



technical aspects of UA and multilingual Internet. Participants learned techniques and best practices to ensure seamless user experiences across languages. The session included hands-on training and interactive demonstrations, enabling participants to grasp the practical implementation of UA.

10. Social Media Promotions, Social Media Posts and Authored Article The Local India Chapter of Universal Acceptance (UA) actively engaged the UA Community via regular social media promotion and raised awareness about UA and EAI. FICCI-ILAI's Twitter account disseminated information, updates and insights on the importance of UA and EAI in achieving a truly inclusive digital environment.



#### 2.1.4 SRI LANKA UA LOCAL INITIATIVE

In October 2022, to raise awareness of IDN ccTLDs and address technological gaps in Sri Lanka, research and development company Theekshana officially founded a UA Local Initiative with the support of ICANN. LK Domain Registry is an active participant in the UA Local Initiatives project. It has supported Theekshana in enhancing the promotion of two IDNs in Sri Lanka by speeding up the process to issue IDNs for free. LK Domain Registry released reserved domain name email.lk and its equivalent in Sinhala, ඉතැපැලි.ලංකා by LK Domain Registry and Tamil script இதபால்.இலங்கை to Theekshana to set up an EAI-ready email platform.

The staff of almost all major Internet service providers, ICTA, LK Domain Registry, academia, etc., participated in the first workshop.

Sri Lanka needs more training and awareness of UA. Sri Lankan universities are required to introduce UA in IT-related curricula. The government hierarchy has to be aware of the two ccTLD IDNs and the possibility of having Sinhala and Tamil IDNs pointing to Sinhala and Tamil content.

#### Achievements in ten months:

- Increased awareness among the Sri Lankan public about two ccTLD IDNs.
- Theekshana set up two EAI-supporting email platforms.
- Trained major ISPs on UA and EAI.
- Currently, Sri Lanka has a small but vibrant community that likes to embrace UA.
- Ongoing capacity building has built resources to maintain UA-compliant software and servers and EAI-compliant email server platforms.
- UA adoption has begun in a small way, and on 24 August 2023, the equivalent of gov. lk in Sinhala Script, රජය.ලංකා, has been delegated to ICTA by LK Domain Registry to issue government organizations Sinhala Domain Names in Sinhala pointing to Sinhala content for the first time.
- A newsletter has begun with an active email group with Sinhala email addresses.

The following are some of the major activities conducted by the Sri Lanka UA Local Initiative:

1. 5 December 2022. Theekshana organized a policymakers workshop in which most of the senior management of ISPs, ICA, senior government officials and academia participated. Workshop links:

On the same day, to make people aware of the project, a press conference was launched where all media in Sri Lanka were represented.

Theekshana has already created a Local Language Technical Help Centre (LLTHC) with financial help from LK Domain Registry, which runs a telephone hotline and a web portal (www.helpcentre.lk), where anyone can submit online queries and solicit help with technical issues related to Sinhala and Tamil Unicode.

- 2. 25 August 2023. For the first time, some official websites such as the Sinhala Dictionary Website will carry Sinhala email addresses starting from this date.
- 3. Launched Universal Acceptance Sri Lanka website http://universalacceptance.lk/
- 4. Developed tools for Punycode Generator and DNS Records Checker https://universalacceptance.lk/tools/index 2.html
- 5. Testing Email Server (ව්ශවසම්මූති.ලංකා):
  - Email Server (තැපැල්.ව්ශ්වසම්මුති.ලංකා),
  - Postfix Server (MTA) was configured
  - Dovecote (IMAP/POP server configured and tested for IDNs)
  - In the process of testing Roundcube Webmail and IMAP Client
  - IDNA2003, IDNA 2008- Tested several email clients: Outlook, Thunderbird

### 2.1.5 THAILAND UA LOCAL INITIATIVE

The Thailand UA Local Initiative is spearheaded by the Thai Network Information Center Foundation (THNIC). In FY23, the local initiative sought cooperation with Thailand government agencies to assist in formulating policies or utilizing IDN domains, as well as developing Thai-language email systems that are under consideration.

Furthermore, IDN domains have been distributed to interested business sector agencies or organizations for free use. These include:

THNIC has sought collaboration with universities, namely Thammasat University and Kasetsart University, to offer courses for developing email systems that support local languages or EAI as part of the curriculum. This is currently under consideration.

#### 2.2UA AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

The UASG has identified several ways to promote UA and EAI issues and solutions, one of which is through the UA Ambassador Program. The UASG Ambassador Program was created in 2018 to recruit industry leaders and UA experts who are committed to raising awareness around UA and EAI within their respective spheres. Designated UA Ambassadors are empowered to raise awareness of UA and EAI issues to target stakeholders. There were 13 UA Ambassadors during FY23 located in Benin, Bolivia, China, Egypt, India, Nigeria, South Africa and Türkiye. Their details are posted at <u>uasq.tech</u>. The COVID-19 pandemic had an impact on their outreach, but many were still able to do awareness sessions online during the first half of FY23 along with some face-to-face sessions and UA Day events after the second half.

Overall, the activities conducted by UA Ambassadors have contributed to promoting UA, enhancing awareness of the importance of UA, along with the standardized training for UA adoption that eventually leads to a more inclusive and accessible Internet.

This section shares examples of the outreach and training done by UA Ambassadors.

## 2.2.1 **Benin**

Malick Alassane, from Benin, has been actively involved in promoting Universal Acceptance of domain names and email addresses through various workshops and technical sessions. Activities include:

- 1. 29 April 2022. Participated in a UA workshop at OSIANE 2022, which is the International Summit of Information Technology and Innovation held annually in Brazzaville, Republic of Congo.
- 2. 17 May 2022. Conducted a technical session on UA in Benin for 35 participants, including developers, system administrators, students and directors of information systems.
- 3. 11 November 2022. Gave a talk about the cybersecurity issues introduced by Universal Acceptance of domain names at the Benin DNS Forum, which was attended by more than 300 participants.
- 4. Assisted some organizations in the local community in updating their email systems to support EAI. Worked on Postfix-based mail servers and enabled SMTPUTF8 on Cpanel for IDEMI AFRICA and the University of Abomey Calavi.
- 5. 23 March 2023. Organized a workshop with the Information System director in Benin for over 100 participants.
- 6. 24-25 March 2023. Organized a two-day Benin Universal Acceptance Workshop for UA Day 2023 and contributed as a trainer at Guadeloupe UA

There are three UA Ambassadors from China. Each has contributed in various and collective ways, especially for the UA Day events in China.

About 150 representatives from relevant enterprises and financial institutions participated in the event. In view of the characteristics of the African continent with many languages and prominent local cultures, Mr. Wu promoted UA, emphasized the significance of realizing UA to support a diversified and multilingual Internet, and shared how to support the international technical standard EAI in email systems in the African region.

Introduced the efforts made by the industry to improve the Chinese domain name application environment under the leadership and coordination of ISC in recent years. The latest test report of the Chinese domain name application environment was shared. 50 people from Guangdong Internet Society, Guangdong Trademark Association, some IPR service companies and enterprise users in Guangdong province participated in this event. This seminar showed that under the guidance and support of government authorities and Internet industry organizations, Internet vendors will continue to improve their support for the Chinese domain name application environment, and Chinese domain names will usher in a new high-speed development stage.

Aman Masjide focused on implementation of UA in practice not only within his organization but also for influencing technology enablers. He actively participated and organized some of the following activities:





## **2.4UA DAY**

In FY23, thousands of members of the global Internet community across six continents took part in the inaugural UA Day. Held on 28 March 2023 and organized by ICANN and the UASG, UA Day 2023 was established as a means to rally local, regional and global stakeholders to spread UA awareness and encourage UA adoption through a mix of virtual, in-person and hybrid training sessions. UA Day marked the first time the world's top technical and language communities, companies, governments and DNS industry stakeholders were mobilized to champion UA on a global scale.





UA Day officially kicked off with a keystone event in New Delhi hosted by India's Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) through the National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI), in collaboration with ICANN and the UASG. Dozens of other events were held over a 3-month period from February to May 2023, with most events occurring on or around 28 March 2023. Participants came from many categories of stakeholders, including: business, governments, telecom regulators, research institutions, civil society and non-government organizations, ICANN At-Large Structures, ISOC chapters, IT companies and technology startups, telecom companies. the DNS industry, Internet service providers and hosting providers, and academia.

In total, more than 9,000 people across the world participated in UA Day from more than 40 countries and representing more than 20 languages.











ICANN conducted comprehensive communications outreach to spread UA Day awareness and encourage participation. Two press releases were published:

- UA Day: Global Effort to Drive a More Inclusive Internet 9 March 2023
- Charting Towards a Multilingual and Inclusive Internet 24 March 2023

The press releases garnered more than 1,500 "pickups" by various global media outlets. This coverage was supplemented with additional coverage generated by media inquiries resulting from the press releases, media outreach by ICANN's Communications team, and efforts from UA Day organizers.

ICANN also conducted extensive social media engagement leading up to and on UA Day, including paid social campaigns on Twitter and Facebook. The paid campaigns resulted in over one million impressions/reach and over 3,500 link clicks to the UA Day page. Event organizers also contributed to media outreach and social media campaigns.

# 5. ROLE OF STAKEHOLDERS

Universal Acceptance is a foundational requirement for a truly multilingual Internet and key to unlocking the potential of new gTLDs to foster competition, consumer choice and innovation in the domain name industry. To do this, UA reforms are needed in governments, academia, the domain name industry and technology organizations in collaboration with the language communities. Achieving UA therefore requires a joint effort by multiple stakeholders. Here are the main tasks that each stakeholder should do to adopt UA:

#### **Businesses:**

- Organize internally and assess if your business' systems are compliant with UA standards.
- Update your own IT systems to be UA-ready. See UASG026 UA-Readiness Framework, UASG004 test cases, free code samples, and EAI Self-Certification Guide.

#### Governments:

- Evaluate the possibility of including <u>UA requirements</u> in government procurements.
- Coordinate with your national ccTLD managers and ICANN Governmental Advisory Committee (GAC) delegates to participate in and strengthen UA-related actions.

#### Academia:

- Include UA in research, study and curriculum for subjects like software engineering, computer science and informatics. To support hands-on experience, workshops or hackathons should be organized. (Hackathon case study)
- Upgrade email systems to support EAI.
- Update IT curricula to include teaching and learning of UA and software internationalization-related concepts.

Open-source communities and developers should update their products and systems by deploying UA-ready tools and UA-ready code samples. UA should be a part of all developers' skill sets.

End users should demand more UA-ready systems, and report bugs about non-UA ready systems and applications (report at <a href="https://uasg.tech/global-support-center/">https://uasg.tech/global-support-center/</a>).
